



## Visit MyMedicare.gov

### **Register at MyMedicare.gov to get your personalized Medicare information:**

- Manage your personal information (like medical conditions, allergies, and implanted devices).
- Sign up to get your "Medicare Summary Notices" (eMSNs) and the "Medicare & You" handbook electronically. You won't get printed copies if you choose to get them electronically.
- Manage your personal drug list and pharmacy information.
- Search for, add to, and manage a list of your providers and access quality information about them.
- Track Original Medicare claims and your Part B deductible status.
- Print an official copy of your new Medicare card once it's mailed to you.



# Use the Blue Button<sup>®</sup> & Blue Button 2.0

## Use Blue Button to:

- Download and save a file of your personal health information on your computer or other device.
- Print or email this information to share with others.
- Import this information into other computer-based health management tools.

## Use Blue Button 2.0:

Connect your Medicare health information to other services you trust, like applications (apps), which can help you manage and improve your health. Options might include using an app to keep track of regular tests and services you need or to track your health over long periods of time.
